
The museum has opened for the season! It is staffed entirely by volunteers so if you can help, please contact **Sherry Moreau**.

Total Solar Eclipse

A total solar eclipse will take place August 21, 2017 and, as luck would have it, there is no better place to view the eclipse than Rocheport, MO!! Rocheport is considered to be in the path of totality. This means that the eclipse will last the longest along its path. The total duration is expected to be about 90 minutes. This will be the first time since August 7, 1869 that a total solar eclipse will come to Missouri.

Rocheport intends to have entertainment throughout the weekend leading up to the eclipse on Monday, August 21st. Watch for details of the festivities at www.rocheport-mo.com.
